## Prenatal Financial Information Sheet

### Welcome to Goodwin Community Health's Prenatal Program!

To provide you with a better understanding of the cost and benefit to receiving exceptional prenatal services here at Goodwin Community Health , we have provided you with this sheet explaining the costs associated with our program, regardless of your financial status.

The following prices reflect an **ESTIMATED** cost of your future prenatal appointments. It is important that you understand your financial responsibility prior to the start of services . Please note that prices are subject to change at any time.

If you do not currently have Medicaid or any kind of insurance you are considered a self-pay patient. A \$30 minimum deposit is required at each appointment. If you are pending insurance through New Hampshire or Maine Medicaid you will still be expected to pay this deposit until your application has been approved. If GCH owes you money for visits that could be submitted to your new insurance you will be refunded.
